Posters will be displayed at the 2017 Veteran's Day Observance, (11 November 2017, at 11:00, Mocksville town square near the Veteran's Memorial, weather permitting)

The top essay winners will be asked to read their essays at the observance

The top poster winners will be asked to explain their posters at the observance

Posters: make sure that the entrant's name, age, grade, school, and telephone number are on the back of the poster so the child and parent can be contacted to be at the Observance

Essays: Must be typewritten, double-spaced, no more than 1000 words long. Make sure that the entrant's name, age, grade, school, and telephone number are on the back of the last page of the essay so the child and parent can be contacted to be at the Observance.
